- Proficiency in Microsoft office and an aptitude for technical information
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES -**

- Works with stakeholders, particularly emergency response personnel to establish viable working relationships and to conduct
  emergency planning/preparedness exercises on behalf of the airport, including live, tabletop and internal operational training
  exercises
- Develops implements and maintains manuals (Airport Emergency Plan, Safety Manual, Airside Traffic Directives, etc.)
- Manages the continued development of the Airside Vehicle Operator's Permit (AVOP) program
- Investigates employee related injuries, accidents and property damage. Determines cause and consults management on appropriate remedies to prevent future occurrences. Compiles and maintains incident reports and logs
- Conducts regular on-site visits to inspect and perform safety audits of NAD workplace environments and practices
- Coordinates safety requirements of consultants or contractors brought on site to conduct work. Defines work parameters, monitors compliance and provides feedback to the relevant department(s)
- Assists in the coordination of the Joint Occupational Safety & Health Committee meetings and related activities
- Promotes airport community awareness of the importance of safety & emergency planning/preparedness through seminars, workshops, displays, brochures, etc.
- Assists with the development and implementation of new safety & emergency planning/preparedness policies and procedures in response to changing local government regulations, international standards, and/or major events or incidents
- Works in close partnership with both government (NEMA) and private organizations (Bahamas Red Cross Association, BASRA, etc.) to ensure support during an emergency
- Develops, implements and maintains an adequate floor warden program
- Conducts monthly inspections of fire alarm system
- Assist with the implantation, promotion and maintenance of the airport's Safety Management System (SMS)
- Assists with other Airside Operations & Public Safety Department programs as required
- Shift coverage for airside team.
