ELECTRICAL TECHNICIAN Level I - (Night Shift) MAINTENANCE AND ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT

JOB SUMMARY:

An Electrical Technician team member is responsible for responding to Airfield Electrical maintenance calls on the Airside and general electrical maintenance calls throughout the facilities inclusive of performing scheduled and non-schedule preventative maintenance (PM) on all electrical equipment in a timely fashion. The team member will also ensure that all routine maintenance calls are addressed and corrected in order to minimize downtime for all airport assets.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responds primarily to Airfield electrical maintenance calls on a timely basis;
- Ensures that all workplace safety rules are always adhered to;
- Responds to general electrical maintenance calls on a timely basis;
- Provides a report on the nature of the problem and the corrective action taken;
- Where necessary, order required parts/supply materials list for job responsibility;
- Operates and uses the Computer Maintenance Management Software (CMMS);
- Advises work control of the status of each maintenance call;
- Provide regular updates to the Operations Center;
- Work collaboratively with the Airside Specialist.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or Associate degree in Electrical Power is preferred
- Single phase license or successfully completed of the single-phase license exam
- Knowledge of three phase electrical theory and work is a plus
- 5-8 years' experience in a hand on multi-functional maintenance environment
