**JOB SUMMARY:** - To perform general maintenance work around and on Lynden Pindling International Airport's airfield, runways, grounds, and equipment.

**KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** -

- Performs a variety of tasks in the operation, repair, and maintenance of airport buildings, grounds, runways, facilities, and equipment.
- Mows, trims, cuts weeds or bushes, and sprays herbicide applications on grounds as required.
- Picks up trash, rocks, leaves, limbs, and debris, and loads into cart/truck/bins for removal.
- Operates equipment used in maintenance of the airport including tractor with mowing machine or front loader, backhoe, line painting machine, chemical spreader.
- Performs preventive maintenance on airport equipment and grounds.
- Conducts maintenance inspections and reports deficiencies.
- Operates two-way radio in coordinating activities with the airport control tower.
- Utilizes necessary equipment including hand and power tools to complete airfield and grounds maintenance work.
- Loads, unloads, and maneuvers a variety of materials and equipment such as saws, drills, herbicides, etc.
- Drives vehicles and equipment with both standard and automatic transmissions to a variety of work sites.
- Reads and applies instructions and labels for product and equipment operation.
- Utilizes appropriate safety equipment and procedures.
- Maintains simple records, logs, etc. as required.
- Performs related work as required.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** - Any combination of education, training, and experience providing the following knowledge, skills, and abilities:

**A. Experience, Education, and Training:** -

- High school diploma
- Training certification in related field
- Experience in the construction, maintenance, or repair of buildings and grounds.
- Experience must include operating light to medium construction equipment and vehicles.

**B. Knowledge:** -

- Principles, procedures, and equipment involved in construction, maintenance and repair of pavement, grounds, or other related projects.

**C. Abilities: -**

- Perform general maintenance work on airfields, grounds, and buildings.
- Operate, in a manner consistent with safety principles, such equipment as tractor, front loader, backhoe, line painting machine.
- Perform preventive maintenance on equipment.
- Follow oral and written instructions.
- Maintain accurate records and logs.
- Communicate effectively verbally.
- Deal effectively and courteously with associates and the public.
- Presents an overall professional image for the position.
- Perform effectively as a member of the AFMT/NAD team in carrying out the Company's stated mission and philosophy.
- Perform the essential functions of the job without posing a direct threat to the health and safety of others.

**D. Physical Requirements: -**

- Performs bending, squatting, kneeling, twisting, and reaching to both ground level and overhead.
- Lifts and carries up to 50 pounds.
- Pushes and pulls up to 75 pounds.
- Holds and grips objects.
- Subject to working in awkward positions and periods of prolonged walking, sitting, or standing.

**E. Working Environment: -**

- Primarily outdoors with exposure to dust and pollen
- Subject to a variety of extreme weather conditions
- Susceptible to mechanical, electrical, and chemical hazards associated with equipment and maintenance duties.
- Subject to constant and extreme noise, poor lighting, and fumes

**F. Licensing/Certification: -**

- Must possess a valid driver's license.

**G. Miscellaneous Requirements: -**

- Subject to a work schedule with varying days off.
- Subject to emergency call-in.
