JOB SUMMARY: - The multi-disciplined Maintenance Response team, Electrician Level IV, will respond in a timely fashion to daily maintenance calls throughout the facilities inclusive of performing scheduled and non-scheduled PM on all electrical equipment. The job requires exceptional knowledge of single phase and three phase electrical installations, single phase and three phase motors installation, maintenance and troubleshooting, electrical control wiring and maintenance, general generator controls knowledge and maintenance. HV switchgear maintenance and operation would be a plus. Perform inspections and check LPIA's equipment and systems and assist with the preventative (PM) and corrective maintenance on all Electrical systems throughout the facility and on the airfield. This team will ensure that all routine maintenance calls are addressed and corrected to minimize downtime for all airport assets.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES-

- Install and maintain single phase and three phase electrical motors, equipment, and systems.
- Perform general maintenance on generators and switchgears.
- Assist with the airfield lighting repairs and maintenance.
- Supervisor all electrical equipment controls repairs and maintenance.
- Works closely with Plumbing, HVAC, and Facilities teams to ensure that the repair and maintenance activities of LPIA's assets are completed in a timely fashion.
- Assists with the execution of the preventive maintenance (PM) programs.
- Keeps the work area clean and free of any debris.
- Respond to maintenance calls in a timely manner.
- Assess the nature of the problem and take corrective action.
- Where necessary, order required parts/supply materials list for job at hand.
- Ability to fill out work orders electronically.
- Advise work control of the status of each maintenance call.
- Ensure that all workplace safety rules are adhered to at all times.

- Trade certifications in Electrical installation or relevant disciplines.
- 5-8 years' experience in a hand on multi-functional maintenance environment.
- Ability to troubleshoot complex wiring circuits.
- Excellent working knowledge of building codes and relevant trades.

- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office applications, including Microsoft Project software is a plus.
- Demonstrated ability to train junior staff on electrical equipment and systems.
