- Work closely with baggage/check in agents to ensure the delivery of bags through BHS to the makeup units
- Retrieve bags for USCBP in a timely manner for inspection
- Ensure bags are returned to baggage agents for transport to aircraft
- Transport special bags from special bag counter to the makeup carousels
- Assist with the Preventive Maintenance programs for BHS and ADB
- Remove / scan bags from the run-off belt and return to makeup carousels
- Keep the work area clean and free of any debris
- Participant in all equipment training classes
- Any other duties assigned
