- Upload, maintain, and verify sales and operational data in Power BI, Active Concession Management System, and other internal platforms.
- Execute and analyze periodic commercial surveys to assess customer satisfaction, operational performance, and market trends.
- Help develop and evaluate monthly benchmarking reports to monitor concessionaire performance and provide feedback for continuous improvement.
- Contribute to board reporting materials and other executive presentations.

## **Administrative and Compliance Support**

- Help prepare supporting documentation for internal audits and tenant reviews.
- Assist in tracking and monitoring agreement compliance across the concession portfolio.
- Maintain organized records and databases to support reporting accuracy and audit readiness.
